Senior wartime Veterans and/or their spouses may be eligible to receive a significant monthly payment from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA)

The Aid & Attendance Pension was instituted by the VA in 1952 to help senior wartime Veteran families pay for senior living or in-home care, nationwide.

This monthly pension is TAX-FREE

If you or your spouse served at least 1 day of active duty during one or more of the wartime periods listed below, you may qualify for the Aid & Attendance Pension!

WARTIME PERIODS PENSION AMOUNTS

World War II
12/07/1941 - 12/31/1946 Two Married Veterans
\$3,740/mo.

Korean War
06/27/1950 - 01/30/1955 One Married Veteran
\$2,795/mo.

Vietnam War (in country)
Begins 1955 Single Veteran
\$2,358/mo.

Vietnam War (all)
08/05/1964 - 05/07/1975 Healthy Veteran
(spouse needs care)
\$1,863/mo.

Gulf War Surviving Spouse of Veteran
08/02/1990 - TBD \$1,515/mo.
